Funding and advice to earthquake strengthen heritage buildings

Heritage EQUIP is the government programme supporting seismic upgrades for New Zealand's earthquake-prone heritage buildings. We make funding available to private building owners, and upgrade guidance is available to all online at heritagequip.govt.nz

Heritage EQUIP is now providing even more assistance in the regions:

- Up to 67% funding to support seismic upgrade works
- · Grants now also available for professional advice
- · Extra incentives are available for multiple building applications.

There's also extra funding available if the proposal builds technical capacity in regional New Zealand.

We're actively seeking proposals from eligible entities working on behalf of groups of building owners, to aggregate multiple buildings into a single professional advice or upgrade works funding application.

Entities we can fund for multiple building proposals include:

- Professional advisers like structural engineers, heritage consultants and conservation architects
- Heritage trusts and town centre or heritage-focused charitable entities
- · Territorial authorities

Grants for professional advice, and grants for multiple buildings, are only available for regional projects in medium or high seismic risk areas.
