


>>> OUTREACH CLINIC - MŌKAU


CLIENT INTERACTIONS

The Heartlands Hub has a meeting room with kitchen, bathroom, whiteboard and video-conferencing facilities. We call this our 'hui hub' and it is available, free of charge, to Government Agencies and community organisations who wish to;

- Meet with clients or members of the public,
- Offer drop-in clinics or appointments,
- Facilitate workshops that are open to the public,
- Hold community group hui/meetings.
