## Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this business paper is to set out the proposed timetable for Council to hear Submitters speak in support of their submissions to the 2023 Speed Management Plan and the Public Places Bylaw 2023, and to refer the verbal submissions for deliberation with all written submissions at the Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday 28 November 2023.

Note: The Public Health and Safety Bylaw 2023 was also consulted on with no submissions received.

- 1.2 Distributed separately and forming part of this business paper are Submission Booklets comprising copies of all submissions received to the 2023 Speed Management Plan and the Public Places Bylaw 2023.

Important Notes for a Hearing:

- 1 Elected Members are reminded of their responsibility to consider all submissions with an open mind and without any pre-determination.

*This does not mean that Members' cannot have an opinion – it simply means that as an elected Member you must be prepared to listen to alternative views and to change your own views should you be convinced.*

- 2 Elected Members may only ask questions for clarification purposes.
- 3 No debate is to be entered into between any Elected Member(s) and Submitter(s).

## 2023 Speed Management Plan

- 2.1 At the Speed Management Plan consultation closing deadline of Monday 11 September 2023 a total of twenty seven (27) submissions were received. Sixteen (16) of these were standard submissions received either online, via email or via post (Submission Numbers 1 to 16). Eleven (11) of these were via Social Pinpoint (Submission Numbers 17a to 17k)
- 2.2 No late submissions have been received.
- 2.3 Of the twenty seven (27) submissions received, six (6) Submitters indicated they wish to be heard in support of their written submissions.

## Public Places Bylaw 2023 and Public Health and Safety Bylaw 2023

- 3.1 At the Bylaws consultation closing deadline of Sunday 29 October 2023 only two (2) submissions were received. Both submissions relate to the Public Places Bylaw 2023. No submissions were received to the Public Health and Safety Bylaw 2023.
- 3.2 No late submissions have been received for either Bylaw.
- 3.3 Of the two (2) submissions received, one (1) Submitter indicated they wish to be heard in support of their written submission.
