We provide a weekly Kerbside Refuse and Recycling Collection Service for Te Kuiti, Piopio, Mokau/ Awakino and Waitomo Village (rural ward). This service will collect **only** WDC blue refuse bags and green bin from the kerb outside of your property.

For health and safety reasons we ask that:

- Broken glass is well wrapped in
- newspaper.
  The weight of a full bag does
- The weight of a full bag does not exceed 15kg.
- Tie the bag handles securely.

Place your refuse bags on the kerbside by 8:00am on the day of collection. Piopio, Mokau/ Awakino, Waitomo Village (and rural ward) collection takes place on Tuesday. Te Kuiti's kerbside collection service takes place on Friday.

You can purchase WDC blue refuse bags for \$2.70 from the Waitomo District Landfill, rural Waste Transfer Stations, local supermarket outlets, Mokau Museum and the Junction Service Station in Awakino.

We encourage residents to use blue rubbish bags to dispose of household waste that cannot be recycled or composted at home. Items like plastic food wrap, wax coated paper, used tin foil, potato chip bags, polystyrene, styrofoam, sanitary items, and plastic types (3, 4, 5, 6, 7).

## **Collection of recyclables**

A Green Bin is provided to properties that receive the Kerbside Collection service. The bin is for recycling household items such as tin and aluminium cans, green/ clear and brown glass bottles, glass jars, paper and cardboard items. Only plastic types 1 and 2 are accepted. You can check for the symbol on the underside of plastic containers and bottles.

Please do not place solvent cans, tin foil / food wrap, light bulbs or other unrecyclable items in your green bin.

Sort your recycling and fit more in your green bin. Rinse and squash plastics. Remove and discard any lids (or re-use them for another purpose). Paper and cardboard should be flattened, stacked and secured in a clear plastic bag with handles tied or with string. Place paper and cardboard recycling next to your green bin. Residential volumes of paper and cardboard will be accepted as part of the service. Large volumes of recycling must be taken to Waitomo District Landfill - there is no charge for recycling.

The Landfill is located on William Street Te Kuiti and is open from Wednesday to Sunday, from 9am to 4pm.
