Do you have any inorganic household items lying round that you want to get rid of? Now is the time to start sorting out those bits and bobs you no longer use in preparation for this years Inorganic Collection!

As long as it's inorganic! That means NO REFUSE, NO FOOD, NO COMPOST and NO HAZARDOUS WASTE - just your unwanted household items.

A couple of reminders to help this collection work for everyone:

- Items must be moveable by one man (ie; weigh less than 30kg).
- Food and compost will not be collected!
- Hazardous waste will not be collected (no car batteries, paint tins, pesticides, chemicals of any sort, oil, asbestos or old gas bottles).
- No household solid waste (refuse) will be collected.

If you live within the town boundaries of the listed townships, WDC's Solid waste and recycling collection contractor SuperBins, will collect your unwanted household items FREE from the kerbside outside your house.

- Te Kuiti (East side of Railway line) Tuesday 26th October
- Te Kuiti (West side of Railway line) Wednesday 27th October Mokau/ Awakino - Tuesday 26th October
- Benneydale Thursday 28th October
- Marokopa Friday 29th October
- Piopio Friday 29th October
- Waitomo Village Monday 1st November

Please put your inorganic items on the kerbside by 4pm on the day prior to your areas collection date. If you don't put it out for collection, you'll have to hold onto it for another year, so start sorting now.
