WATER RESTRICTIONS FOR MOKAU / AWAKINO

These townships are now on Water Alert Level 1 - Conservation.

WATER ALERT LEVEL 1 -CONSERVATION

- Avoid watering gardens during the day (early morning or late evening is best), use a water saving attachment on your hose and do not leave hoses running unattended. Avoid washing paths and driveways, use a broom.
- Avoid re-filling your swimming pool and use a pool cover.
- Turn off the tap when brushing your teeth or shaving.

The recent rainfall combined with the current level of water consumption means Council can reduce the Water Alert Level for Mokau / Awakino townships. Council would like to thank residents for their support in the adoption of water conservation measures during the drought. Your continued efforts to reduce water wastage indoors and outside, will ensure that there is plenty of water available for everyone.
