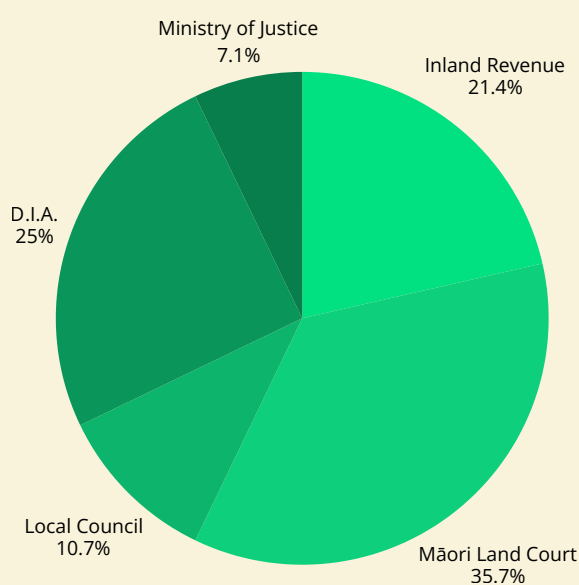

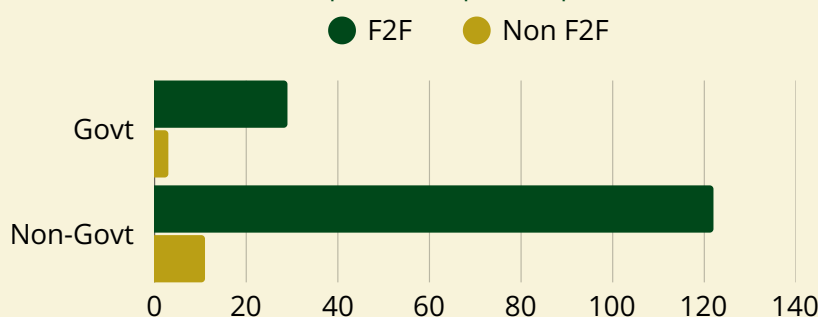
CLIENT INTERACTIONS

NEUTRAL SPACE TO MEET CLIENTS

If you need a neutral space to meet with clients, Heartlands Te Kūiti has a separate meeting room next door at 73 Rora Street, Te Kūiti. It is equipped with kitchen, bathroom, whiteboard and video-conferencing facilities and comfortably fits up to 15 people. We call this our 'hui hub' and it is available, **free of charge**, to Government Agencies and community organisations who wish to;

- Meet with clients or members of the public,
- Offer drop-in clinics or appointments,
- Facilitate workshops that are open to the public,
- Hold community group hui/meetings.
