Catchment water testing funded by MPI will be started in February. We will be collecting eDNA tests from 8 sites around the region as well as 26 new quarterly water quality monitoring sites. Sites have been selected to complement existing Waikato Regional Council (WRC) testing.

Here's looking forward to the summer's abundance, with thanks to all for sharing your surplus.







Councillor's **Update**

I wish to say a big thank you to all the participants in the Christmas Parade, and to all those that crowded the road side to admire and cheer their efforts. But an even bigger thank you must go to the organising volunteers who have shouldered the challenge of getting the 'show on the road'. This 'show' also includes the closing of State Highway 3, for which we are lucky to have a suitable detour, so a big thank you also to the Inframax team for their traffic management expertise. This is a shining example of how important 'volunteering' is to our community wellbeing, so a big thank you to those who have, and those that still do, and to those who haven't yet, don't be afraid to offer your services, or say yes if asked.

All Councils around New Zealand are currently struggling through the process of compiling their Ten Year Plans, which comprise the budget for the next financial year, (2021/2022), and forecasts for the subsequent nine years. We have settled on the projects, policies, and proposals we wish to take forward and the staff are modelling those plans to produce the 'first cut'



financials which will be presented to us Phone 8778033/0273479843 next month. This will show the Rates Revenue requirement, and the borrowing or debt reduction options. We will then closely analyse the details for financial prudence and ratepayer affordability, as we always have, while ensuring our infrastructure is adequately maintained and that our 'levels or service' to our Ratepayers and customers are maintained.

A number of Councils around the country have already received their 'first cut' financials and some have scarily high rate increase requirements. I won't predict where our 'first cut' may land, but after intense scrutiny we will settle on a proposal in early March that will then be comprehensively audited, before adoption for consultation in mid-April.

On a different note, if you have any queries or complaints about a Council Service, please ring the Council on 0800 932 4357 and lodge a 'service

request'. This service is available 24hrs a day, 7 days a week.
