The Taiohi Advisory Group aims to:

- provide advice and guidance to the Ministry of Youth Development from a youth perspective
- represent a youth perspective in decision making/youth voice opportunities (e.g. presentations, funding and interview panels. representative groups)
- link the Ministry of Youth Development with key issues from young people and develop the skills and experiences of its members.

Selection criteria – are you (please tick).....

- aged between 12 and 24 years of age
- able to provide a youth perspective on decisions and consider how they support young people in the community (this may include time to read funding applications)

□ confident to speak in a group made up of adults and young people

able to understand issues facing a range of young people

- understand confidentiality and act honestly
- □ able to attend (and willing to travel) for meetings within the Bay of Plenty and Waikato region

The selection process

Once applications close, members of the Taiohi Advisory Group and Ministry of Youth Development staff will select a shortlist.
