

Waitomo District Council Review of Trade Waste Bylaw 2006

Waitomo District Council has reviewed the Trade Waste Bylaw as part of the general review of its bylaws as required by the Local Government Act (2002).

The reviewed bylaw enables Council to establish clear rules for the discharge of trade waste to Council's sewerage system. In doing so Council protects the integrity of the sewerage system and ensures the discharge from the system meets appropriate environmental standards.

The main changes from the 2006 Bylaw are that it is proposed that there will be five grades of trade waste rather than three and there will be four types of trade waste permits instead of two.

Under the revised bylaw a charge in the form of a targeted trade waste rate is proposed for three of the trade waste categories: Exempted, Permitted and Conditional.

The controlled category of trade waste will continue to operate on the charging system already in place and operational.
