Proposal for Closure of Road/ Street to Ordinary Vehicular Traffic

Rangitoto Road – Starting from its intersection with Barber and Tahaia Bush Roads, to finish just before the driveway to Te Kuiti Meat Processors and House 91, which is 880 metres from its intersection with The Esplanade. <u>Including</u> <u>intersections with</u>: Thompson Road (No Exit), Pururu West Road (No Exit), Pururu East Road (No Exit), Ngapeke Road, Ahoroa Road (No Exit), and Tate Road (No Exit).
