

# WDC Notices

## **Proposal for Closure of Road/ Street to Ordinary Vehicular Traffic**

PURSUANT to the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, notice is hereby given that the Waitomo District Council, for the purpose of the **Targa New Zealand 2013 Rally** proposes to close the following roads/streets to ordinary vehicular traffic for the periods indicated:

**Date:** **Thursday 31 October 2013**

**Period of Closure:** **12.35pm to 3.35pm**

**Streets/Roads:** **Barber Road** – Starting from the district boundary, to its intersection with Tahaia Bush and Rangitoto Roads.

**Rangitoto Road** – Starting from its intersection with Barber and Tahaia Bush Roads, to finish just before the driveway to Te Kuiti Meat Processors and House 91, which is 880 metres from its intersection with The Esplanade. Including intersections with: Thompson Road (No Exit), Pururu West Road (No Exit), Pururu East Road (No Exit), Ngapeke Road, Ahoroa Road (No Exit), and Tate Road (No Exit).

**Note:** To assist with the stage security, the closure is also to include 100 metres of EACH adjoining road, from where it intersects with the road being applied for.

**Date:** **Thursday 31 October 2013**

**Period of Closure:** **1.45pm to 5.15pm**

**Streets/Roads:** **Oparure Road** – Starting from its intersection with Troopers Road, to its intersection with Mairoa and Ngapaenga Roads. Including intersections with: Waipapa and Waitepipi Roads.

**Mairoa Road** - Starting from its intersection with Oparure Road and Ngapaenga Road, to its intersection with Mangaotaki Road. Including intersections with: Pungarehu and Kihikihi Roads.

**Note:** To assist with the stage security, the closure is also to include 100 metres of EACH adjoining road, from where it intersects with the road being applied for.

Any person objecting to the proposal is called upon to lodge notice of objection and grounds thereof in writing, before **5.00pm on Wednesday 2 October 2013** at the office of Waitomo District Council, Queen Street, Te Kuiti.
