Task Instructions

Design a board game:

This can be done in anyway you like (on paper, or the back of a cereal box). The library will provide counters and dice to enable you to play it afterwards.

Find 5 new facts about an animal of your choice:

These facts can be found online, in books or by asking other people. Come in and tell the library staff about what you have found out.

Attend a library event

This can be any event held in the library over the school holidays.

 Find a word you don't know, and find out what it means.

This can be any word you have heard or seen in a book. You can use a dictionary, internet or any other form to find out the meaning.
