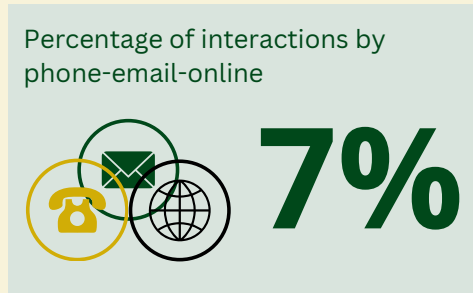
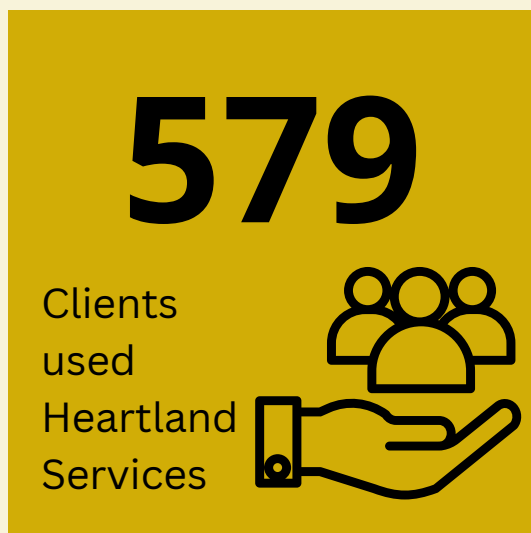
## >>> CHRISTMAS/NEW YEAR CLOSEDOWN

## NEUTRAL SPACE TO MEET CLIENTS

The Heartlands Hub has a meeting room with kitchen, bathroom, whiteboard and video-conferencing facilities. We call this our 'hui hub' and it is available, free of charge, to Government Agencies and community organisations who wish to;

- Meet with clients or members of the public,
- Offer drop-in clinics or appointments,
- Facilitate workshops that are open to the public,
- Hold community group hui/meetings.

The hui hub is available between operational hours of 9am to 5pm and suitable for up to 10-12 people. A hireage fee is charged for private bookings. Contact us by phone or email to make a booking.
