Dog Control Policy and Practices

On 24 September 2013 a report pursuant to Section 10A of the Dog Control Act 1996 was adopted by Waitomo District Council. The report contains information and statistics on Waitomo District Council's dog control activity for the year 1 July 2012 to 30 June 2013.

Revised programme for Road Works – Rora Street Te Kuiti

Waitomo District Council has revised its timeline for the planned renewal programme for Rora Street.

The project will now be separated into two separate components and the timeline for the work also separated into two portions. The first piece of work will be the renewal of the existing in-ground services (A) which will take place pre Christmas. And the second portion will be the renewal of the road sub base, surfacing and associated kerb, channel and footpath work (B) which will take place post Christmas.

It is estimated that the in ground services part (A) could be completed in 3 to 4 weeks with work commencing in October 2013 and the rest of the work (B) completed in late January and February 2014.

WDC are confident that dividing the project Part 3 work into a Project 3(A) and a 3(B) will result in a minimum of additional complication. We look forward to the successful completion of this work which forms a key element to the Te Kuiti Railway Buildings project. The overall outcome will serve to improve the main street of Te Kuiti and create a vibrant and thriving hub for the future enjoyment of our communities and local businesses.
