The following details the number of meetings, workshops and other commitments that Waitomo District elected members have had to commit to for the current 2022-2025 Triennium.

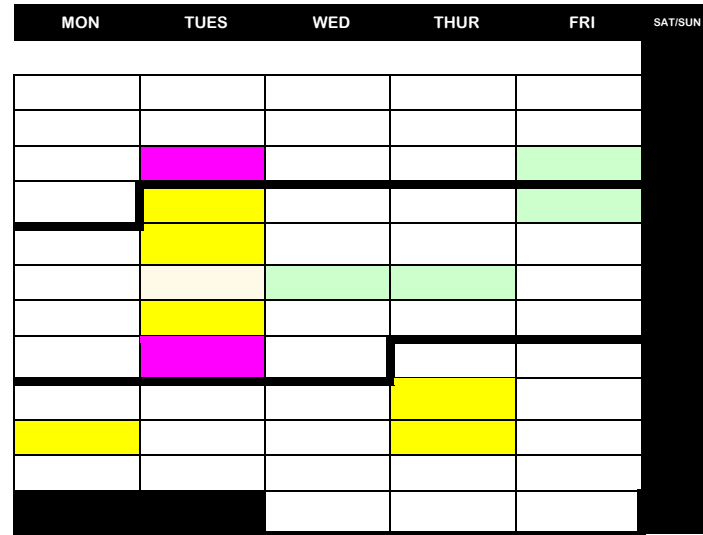
The 2025-2028 Triennium will require at least as much of a commitment, if not more.

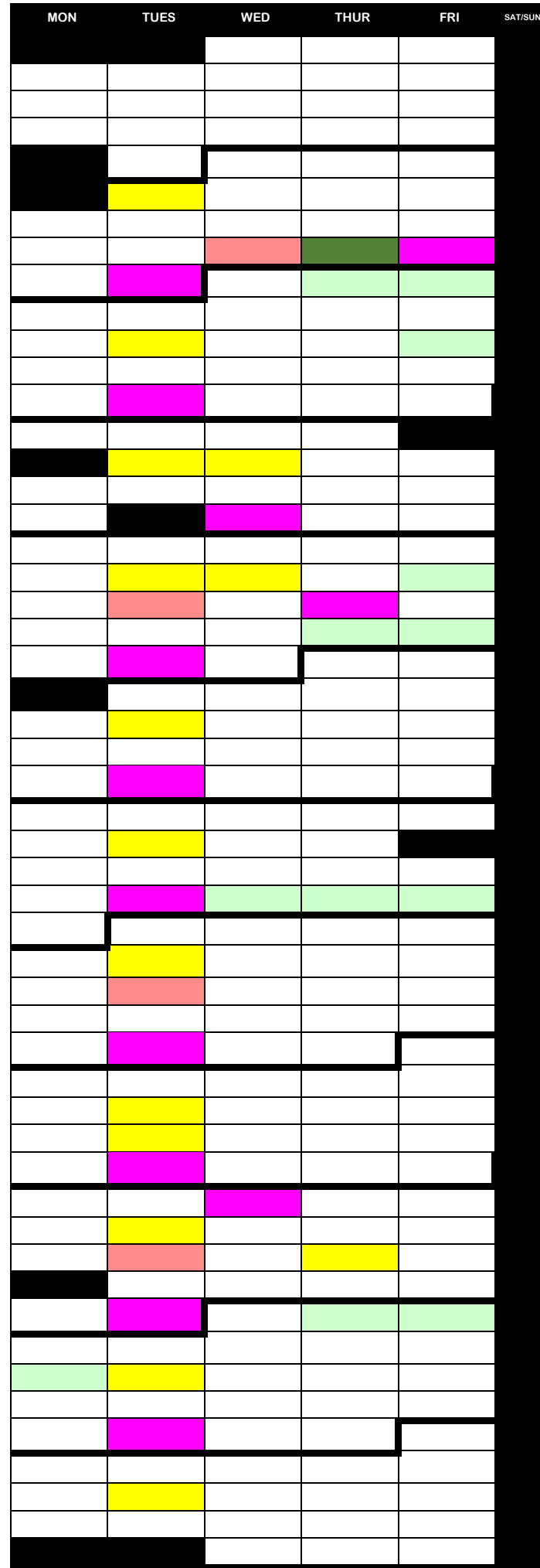

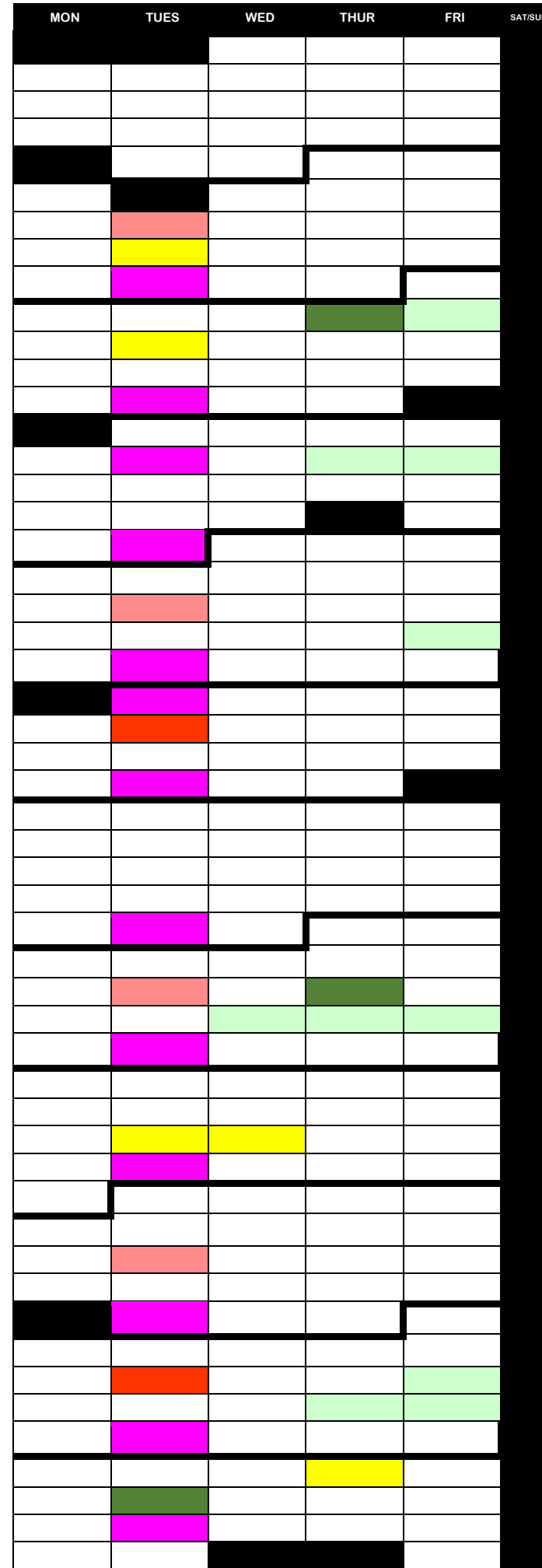
