- ① Coming down the hill towards Boddie Rd from Smart Plants, the corner at the bottom is (can be) awkward for drivers unaware of it. There has been fatalities (at least one) on that corner. I feel if the speed limit was lowered people may approach it at a safer speed.
- ② There are often events at the marae with lots of vehicles. It would be safer for through traffic & marae goes to have a lower limit.
- ③ The same for the school - children, teachers, kaumatua, coming & going. It would be safer to have the lower (50 kmh) limit.
