Nominations

Nominations for the above positions open on **Friday 19 July 2019** and must be made on the appropriate nomination paper for each position. Nomination papers and a candidate information handbook can be found either on the relevant council website, or by phoning the contact numbers provided. Completed nomination documents must be received by the relevant electoral officer no later than **12 noon on Friday 16 August 2019**. Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 incl GST, payable by eftpos, cash or on-line banking (see candidate handbook for requirements).

Candidates are encouraged to submit a candidate profile statement and colour photograph for sending out with voting documents to electors. The requirements for profile statements and photos are set out in a candidate handbook which is available with the nomination papers.

All nomination documents must be lodged together. Candidates should refer to the candidate handbook for further details.


