**DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE**

The Waitomo District Licensing Committee has before it an application by **Bruce Neville Tobeck** for a manager's certificate.

Reports have been received from the Police and a Licensing Inspector. No objections have been filed in respect to this application, and it is therefore determined on the papers by the Chairperson alone in accordance with section 191(2) of the Act.

No concerns have been raised in respect to the criteria outlined in section 222 of the Act, in that reporting Agencies believe the applicant is a suitable person to hold a managers certificate.

The applicant is a co-owner and director of the King Country Brewing Company, but has requested that he be granted a manager's certificate to allow him to assist with serving the brewery's products at the Huhu Café. He has sufficient experience and has not come to the attention of enforcement agencies in that time. The applicant holds the current required qualification.

Been satisfied as to the matters to which the Committee must have regard in s.222 of the Act the application is granted. The certificate can be issued immediately for the initial period of one year.
