# **Piopio collection next week**

AGRECOVERY rural recycling is getting closer to smaller communities with a free container pickup in Piopio next week.

Duncan Scotland of Agrecovery says it is the first time the rural recyclers have visited the North King Country.

"The addition of GEA FIL to our participating brands means we have extended the number of dairy-based containers which are free to recycle so we decided to bring collections even closer to predominantly dairying communities."

"With increasing pressure on farmers to make good environmental decisions we want this recycling programme to be as accessible as possible," says Mr Scotland.

The programme started in 2007, and at the end of April one million kilograms of containers had been recycled through it.

"Laid end to end one million kilos of containers would stretch from Auckland to Turangi."

The recycled containers are sent to Astron Plastics in Auckland for processing into items such as underground electrical cable cover.

"Through recycling farmers and growers have avoided using the equivalent of 8500 cubic metres of farm dumps or polluting the air and land by burning plastic," says Mr Scotland.

Containers from more than 60 participating brand owners, including the majority of agrichemical and animal health brands, can be brought in to the collection points.

The one-off Piopio collection is at NZ Farm ery.co.nz or phone 0800 247 326.

Containers must be 0-60 litres, free of chemical residue, dirt and other contamination inside and out, and still have the label on to identify the brand. Triple rinse all containers and drain well.

There is 15 permanent collection sites throughout the Waikato and Bay of Plenty.
