

College U16s take out the comp

HISTORY WAS MADE in August as the Piopio College U16 rugby boys stormed to victory in the John Boe Cup, crowned champions of the Waikato Secondary Schools U16 competition for 2025.

In a pulsating final, the team showed grit, skill, and relentless determination, running away 39-25g winners against a determined Hamilton Boys' High School side.

The match was a true spectacle - a battle of wills, of heart, and of unshakable belief in each other.

Captain Courageous - Hunter Rogers - led from the front for the full 70 minutes, inspiring his teammates with a fearless work rate and unbreakable commitment. Keanu Edkins was ice-cool under pressure, slotting 4 from 5 with the boot and keeping the scoreboard ticking over.

From the very first whistle, the Piopio forward pack laid down a marker, dominating the set piece and muscling up in contact. Their physicality created the perfect platform for our backs to play with freedom and flair.

Credit to Hamilton Boys' High - they fought hard, used the corners smartly, and mauled their way to 5 well-earned tries. But this Piopio side would not be denied.

This win is more than a scoreline; it's the reward for months of hard work, wet-weather trainings, and the bond built between players, coaches, and supporters. It's a testament to the power of unity, determination, and pride in wearing the red, white and black of Piopio College.

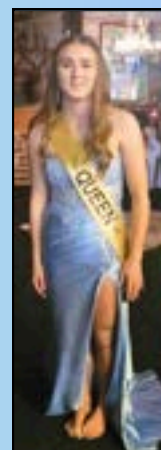

Piopio Retirement Trust Board - update & projects

PAEARUHE VILLAGE has full occupancy and a waiting list for units to become available.

We have wonderful occupants who support each other and, those who are able, contribute greatly to the upkeep and overall appearance of the grounds.

Thomas Young does an awesome job of keeping the lawns tidy in spite of weather challenges.

The Board is keen to proceed with stage two of the double-glazing project as soon as funding permits. This stage involves retrofit glazing to nearly all the windows in the rental units.

We have been fortunate in receiving grants for \$10,000; \$5000 each from

Piopio Lions Club, and Piopio and District Charitable Trust.

We are now looking for further funding of about \$3000, and the rest will be funded from reserves. The total cost of stage two will be circa \$30,000.

We aim to have the double glazing completed before the 2026 winter, with the units being warmer and more energy efficient.

Stage one was completed in 2024 and involved replacing all the back doors and the old wooden French doors with double glazed aluminium doors and ranch-sliders. This was all completed using financial reserves.

Property maintenance is ongoing and in the past year the bathroom area of Unit 16 has been upgraded and Unit 1 has a new deck. Most of the small verandahs have had roofs and gutters replaced.

The Trustees are proud of this great little asset we have in our community.

Piopio Fruit & Veg Stand

OCTOBER is when things start to ramp up in the veggie garden ahead of the summer growing season. I know you know by now not to plant things too early. It's tempting to do so when we think spring has sprung. But Mother Nature almost always delivers a final frost around Labour Weekend as a reminder of who's in charge.

It is time to get your soil supplemented with compost, sheep manure and other good things like blood and bone and lime. Chit seed potatoes and start kumara tipu as well. I start a few pots of zucchini and pumpkins in the glasshouse to have seedling plants ready for Labour Weekend; this helps us get a start on sequential crops over summer so we're eating fresh veggies from the garden as much as possible.

Rest assured the seed trays of heirloom tomatoes are happening in our glasshouse. This year I've started Purple Cherokee, Pink Berkeley Tie Dye, Vintage Brandywine, Dalmatian Oxheart, Black Cherry, and Big Heirloom (seeds saved from last season). Keep an eye out for

news on our annual distribution of seedling tomatoes on the Community Stand's Facebook page around Labour Weekend.

I've got more than enough recycled pots stockpiled in the Pot Palace, but always need those pots back for reuse. Don't forget that the Heritage Food Crops Research Trust in Wanganui will send you free heirloom tomato and heritage bean seeds if you send them a prepaid, self-addressed envelope.

I'm planting dwarf cannellini beans as well as several varieties of heritage climbing beans again this year. "Cherokee Trail of Tears" black beans have been a real favourite for black bean and pumpkin enchiladas this winter.

Your continued contributions to our Community Stand are greatly appreciated. Everything gets taken, even all those lemons!

Thanks to a successful Fielddays, the Lions Club was able to distribute funds to the various community organisations who

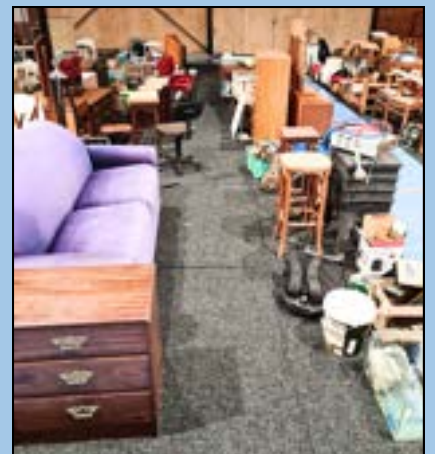
helped out.

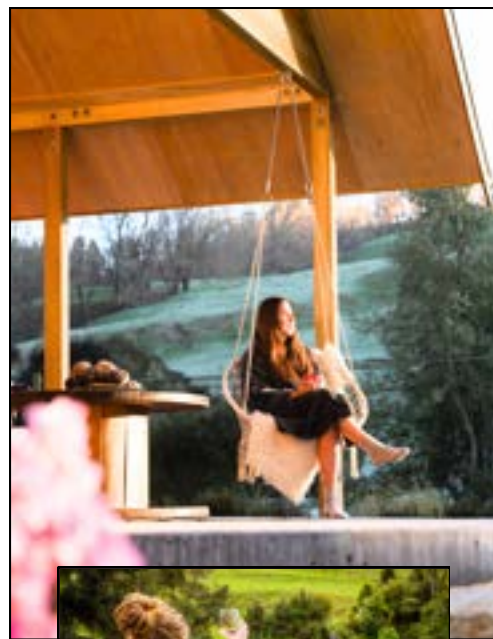
