## Water Supply Update

The water level of the Mokau dam has dropped considerably over the weekend. Therefore **Mokau and Awakino** communities are now on **Water Alert Level 2 Restrictions**. WDC urge residents to conserve water now.

- There is a total ban on domestic sprinklers - only hand held hosing permitted.
- Restrictions apply to all urban, rural, residential, non-residential and commercial properties.

## Te Kuiti, Piopio and Benneydale communities are on Water Alert Level 1 Conservation.

Residents need to conserve water and avoid watering gardens during the day. To reduce evaporation, the ideal time to water gardens is 6am-8am and 6pm-8pm.

- Use a water saving attachment on your hose and do not leave hoses running unattended. Avoid washing paths and driveways, use a broom instead.
- Avoid re-filling your swimming pool and use a pool cover when not in use.
- Turn off the tap when brushing your teeth or shaving.

## Notice for Closure of Road/Street To Ordinary Vehicular Traffic

PURSUANT to the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, notice is hereby given that the Waitomo District Council, for the purpose of the **St. Josephs School Annual Gala 2014** will close the following roads/streets to ordinary vehicular traffic for the periods indicated:

**Date: Friday 14th March 2014**

**Period of Closure: 4.00pm to 8.00pm**

**Streets/Roads:** Queen Street closed between Princes Street and Anne Street Te Kuiti only

**Alternative route(s) available:**

Bayne Street and Seddon Street Te Kuiti

It will be an offence under the above regulations for any person otherwise than under authority to use the road/street for ordinary vehicular traffic during this period of closure.
