Staff held three events over the summer holiday break, alongside their Raumati Toa Reading Programme (run in conjunction with Ōtorohanga District Library). One of the events included the popular Robotic Lego Workshop. All available spaces quickly filled up. Participants worked collaborativley to build a robot with the library's Lego Mindstorm kits.

Lego Mindstorms are a robot kit where individuals can construct their own robotic Lego creation. Using coding, they can programme robots to drive, move and pick up objects.

Participants and caregivers commented on the success of the event and their eagerness to keep learning and refining the skills they had learnt in the workshop.




