#### Mangarino Road, Te Kuiti

Road users are advised that the base of Mangarino Road, at a location at approximately 4kms north of Te Kuiti has been affected by subsidence. subsidence occurred in June 2013. A geotechnical investigation has been carried out and the design of the required repair work is well advanced. It is expected that the necessary road reconstruction work will start early January 2014.

There is a risk of serious further deterioration in the foundation of the road through ongoing subsidence.

For that reason, Waitomo District Council, pursuant to the authority of Schedule 10, Section 11(1) (a) of the Local Government Act 1974 hereby prohibits the use of that affected section of Mangarino Road (from the Te Kuiti Cemetery (new) to Perry's Quarry) by all heavy motor vehicles.
