

Waitomo District Library provides free computing and internet access via the Aotearoa People's Network Kaharoa (APNK).



APNK PCs are available for customer use and are installed with a range of software; Microsoft Word, Open Office, Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Skype, Adobe Acrobat Reader and other programs. Each APNK PC has a DVD and CD drive, USB ports, memory card slots, a webcam and a headset.

There are four PCs for public use available on a first come first served basis, with a session limit of 30 minutes per customer.

There is also free wifi available during library open hours.
