Dog control fees must be paid by **Tuesday 1 July 2014** at the Waitomo District Council offices, Queen Street, Te Kuiti or by posting the registration forms and fees to **Waitomo District Council, PO Box 404, Te Kuiti 3941.**

Dog owners who are new residents of the Waitomo District are required to contact Waitomo District Council.
