

The Northern Virtual e-Library is a collaborative venture between several public libraries in the upper North Island of New Zealand, offering access to quality digital content for their local communities. The OverDrive service is a free digital media platform that allows you to download eBooks and audiobooks.



The first time using our OverDrive collection you will need to download some free software to your computer or mobile device. You only need to do this the first time you use OverDrive or if you want to use a new device to access your eBooks and audiobooks. To use OverDrive, you will need to login using your library card number and PIN. Your PIN number is automatically set as the last four digits of your library card number. This can be changed at any time.

What you will need

- An internet connected computer or mobile device
- Your library card and PIN
- Free Software for PC or Mac: Adobe Digital Editions (eBooks) and/or OverDrive Media Console (audiobooks) or
- Free Software for iPhone, iPod Touch, iPad or Android



This software is available from the Apple App Store, Android Market or the OverDrive Website.

What you can do

- Download eBooks or audiobooks from home at any time
- Transfer eBook titles to your computer or portable devices such as e-readers and smartphones. The eBooks are compatible with most e-readers and mobile devices
- Transfer audio titles to your computer or portable devices such as an mp3 player
- Avoid extended loan charges - the items self expire or you can return eBooks early if you have finished with them

Important Information

- Audiobooks and eBooks are not available for download from library computers, but you can use the wifi to download to your mobile device
- Free software must be installed on your computer or portable device in order to download eBooks and audiobooks.
- Kindles are not OverDrive compatible
