## WATER CONSERVATION

### Level 2 - Restrictions are in place for Te Kuiti, Piopio, Benneydale and Mokau/ Awakino communities.

Your support in conserving water will reduce the need for any future restrictions being placed on the water supply.

- Use sprinklers on alternate days between 6-8am and 6-8pm. This means if your street address is an even number you can use water on even dates of the month only i.e 8 Smith Street, can use a sprinkler or irrigation system on the 4th, 6th, 12th etc.
- Hand held hosing is allowed at anytime.

#### *Quick tips to save water:*

- Turn off all taps when not in use.
- When washing clothes, run full loads or be sure to set controls for a partial load if you are doing less.
- Wait until you have a full load before starting your dishwasher and when possible use the eco-setting.
- Showers are the best way to reduce water usage, but only if they are short. Keep shower time to 3 minutes or less.
