

## ***Waitomo District Rating Information Database - available for public inspection***

Pursuant to Section 28 of the Local Government (Rating) Act 2002, Waitomo District Council gives notice that the region's valuation roll and rates records are available for public inspection at the office of Waitomo District Council, Queen St, Te Kuiti between the hours of 8am and 5pm, Monday to Friday.

The Rating Information Database contains information required by the Council for setting and assessing rates on each rating unit within the Waitomo District. The Owner's names and postal addresses of the properties are available for inspection unless Council has received a request in writing for withholding the owner's names and postal addresses from the database.

All requests for suppression of names and postal addresses must be made in writing and addressed to Waitomo District Council, PO Box 404, Te Kuiti.

Council has recently completed a comprehensive review of the Revenue and Financing Policy, and the Draft Annual Plan currently out for consultation details a number of proposed changes. Upon adoption of the Draft Annual Plan, these changes will be applied to properties as per the information contained in the Rating Information Database.

We encourage you to review the database, which will enable you to be better informed about how the proposed changes might impact the rate levies on your property.
