WATER RESTRICTION UPDATE

Te Kuiti is currently on water restriction Level 3:

- No sprinklers allowed.
- Hand-held hosing only.

Piopio, Mokau and Benneydale communities are now on water restriction Level 2:

- Use sprinklers on alternate days between 6-8am and 6-8pm (e.g. even street numbers on even days; odd street numbers on odd days).
- Hand held hosing is allowed at anytime.
